ERC Visiting Fellowship Programmes (VFP)


ERC promotes the efforts of national and regional authorities that set up and fund mobility programmes to allow potential ERC candidates to visit and gain experience with ERC-funded teams.

VFP in few points:

- Duration of visits **1-6 months** (up to 2019 the minimum duration was 3 month)
- Visiting fellows commit to apply for an ERC grant in specified timeframe
- Visiting fellows need to have a **letter of support** of the proposed host researcher and institution when applying
- National/regional funding agencies cover the travel and salary costs of the fellows for the duration of the visit





ERC VFP: Interested ERC Grantees




ERC VFP: visits distribution by destination country



Visiting Fellows participation in ERC calls

- **58 visiting fellows** have submitted **61 proposals** for an ERC grant after the VFP:
 - 36 (59%) to STG
 - 18 (30%) to COG
 - 7 (11%) to ADG
- 8 visiting fellows (13%) were funded with ERC grants:
 - 4 in PE (PE4, PE8)
 - 3 in SH (SH3, SH5)
 - 1 in LS (LS8)
- 6 of the funded projects are located in EU-13 countries (SI and PL), 2 of the awarded fellows changed HI (BE->UK, HR->IT)
- The success rate of VFP fellows is higher than Widening countries, in particular for STG
- 16% and 20% of ERC grantees 2018-2021 for PL and SI were VFP fellows



The ERC Scientific Council approved the new Mentoring Initiative (MI) proposed by the Working Group on Widening European Participation.

The aim of this initiative is <u>supporting ERC applicants</u> from countries which are not performing well in ERC calls, inspired by the experience of some research agencies and host institutions which put in place programmes to support ERC applicants, but struggle to identify international experts to provide coaching and advise.








Nationality of potential mentors by scientific domain (HI country for former PMs)



- A total of **94 mentors were involved**: **65 ERC grantees** and **29 former PMs**.
- The preferred modality of mentoring activities is the 1:1 remote mentoring, used by all the institutions. Italy and Slovakia are using remote mock interviews. Cyprus and Turkey used pre-screening of proposal and/or review of CVs.
- Cyprus covered travel costs, Poland, Hungary and Malta adopted daily fees, Turkey used project pre-evaluation fees. The other institutions do not foresee financial support to mentors.




ERC MI – Mentors participating





- A total of 94 ERC mentors were involved.
- 65 ERC grantees (69%) and 29 ERC former PMs (31%)


ERC MI – Mentees selection





- A total of 108 potential ERC applicants were selected as mentees.
- Majority of the mentees were targeting 2023 ERC calls.

ERC MI – ERC application results





- A total of 22 mentees already applied to an ERC grant.
- **5 mentees** (23%) were awarded with an ERC grant.
