Visiting Fellowships Programmes

Why? To develop researchers' potential

Who? Researchers from participating countries/agencies

When? Before they apply for their first ERC grant

How? Joining an ERC-funded team for a short period (1 to 6 months)

Important!

- Programmes managed by national authorities
- Conditions vary according to each national or regional funding agency







How they work

The ERC

erc

pean Research Counci

- launches annual calls to its grantees to host visiting researchers to strengthen and diversify their teams
- shares the list of interested grantees with national authorities

National funding agencies

- set own criteria and selection process
- issue annual or open calls
- cover salary and travel costs of selected researchers

Interested researchers

- contact the national authorities and apply to the programme
- if selected, join an ERC-funded team
 - commit to apply for ERC funding in specific timeframe

58 visiting fellows


61 proposals to ERC calls 8 funded (13%)



ERC Mentoring Initiative

Why? To provide applicants with experts' feedback on their proposals or interviews

Who? ERC applicants from participating countries

When? Before submitting the proposal to strengthen the quality of their application OR before interview

How? Through specific national/regional support offices

How it works

The ERC

- Approves the MIs (facilitated by the NCPs)
- launches calls to its grantees and former panel members
- shares the list with NCPs

NCPs

liaise with ERC, interested support offices and experts

National/regional offices

- select the applicants
- contact the experts

Interested ERC applicants

- contact the local office
- if selected, benefit from experts' mentoring

Outcome

94 mentors (65 grantees & 29 former PMs) supported 119 ERC applicants

119 ERC applicants more than 50 applied to ERC calls 6 funded (around 12%)

In 2024, more than 1 000 ERC grantees & former PMs expressed interest to participate as mentors
