- ✓ Increase capacities of less experienced and Widening countries NCPs
- Strengthen national and local support to potential ERC applicants, in particular to those from countries with weak participation in the ERC program

The project supports ERC NCPs network ...

- ➤ ERC News: regular updates of the ERC NCPs community on the latest news in the ERC and in the project activities and outputs
- ➤ Benchmarking of NCP knowledge and services: to map, assess and analyze the ERC NCPs' knowledge, best practices, acquisition of new knowledge needs with a focus on Widening and newcomers
- ➤ Promoting Success Stories and Good Practices: identify and disseminate successful examples and practices in Widening Countries

... and support for ERC applicants

- Domain-specific Workshops and Trainings for ERC Individual Grant Applicants: trans-national online events, each one dedicated to an individual ERC scheme (StG, CoG & AdG) will be organized including dedicated workshops divided within research domains (PE, LS, SH).
- Workshops and Trainings for ERC Synergy Grant (SyG) Applicants: transnational online events.
- Workshops presenting follow-up opportunities for ERC grantees: beyond their ERC project by building a sustainable, long-term funding path'
- ➤ NCP's toolbox: to develop a comprehensive set of guidelines for applicants that address recurring questions and challenges regarding the submission and evaluation phases in the ERC grant application process.

➤ What?

- <u>Proposals Type 1:</u> ERC StG, CoG or AdG, which in the last three years were rated A in the final evaluation, but not funded by the ERC (after application, no evaluation, financial plan adjustment);
 - Proposals Type 2: New applicants
- > Who? Action refers to the individual research projects:
 - Leading & Established researcher & Starting grand
- Beneficiaries are researchers together with Bulgarian universities or research organizations that are accredited to train doctoral students, no portability option.



National Scientific Program "Vihren"

"Excellent Research and People for the Development of European Science"



- **▶ How long?** between 36 and 60 months.
- ➤ <u>How much?</u> The budget depends on project duration and a maximum amount for a five-year period is :
- 400,000 BGN per year for a "Leading Investigator" project.
- 300,000 BGN per year for an "Established Investigator" project.
- 200,000 BGN per year for a "Starting Grant" project. The budget will be reduced on a *pro rata temporis* basis (proportionally in time) if the project duration is shorter.
- ➤ The Program is implemented by the Bulgarian National Science Fund (BNSF), and the financing is through the budget of the Ministry of Education and Science.
